FAQs

Q: Can navigators assist with Medicare questions?

A: Navigators can assist with Medicaid eligibility questions and applications and QMBs. We often refer people with Medicare questions to SHIP Counselors.

Q: How can navigators help Veterans?

A: Navigators can assist Veterans and their families to compare their options for health coverage to find the most affordable solution whether it be Marketplace coverage, VA benefits, HIP, or Medicaid. Information about SHIP Counselors or other agencies that can assist consumers with the questions they may have that we cannot answer (i.e. tax information that is specific to how to file their taxes, Medicare questions, etc.)
